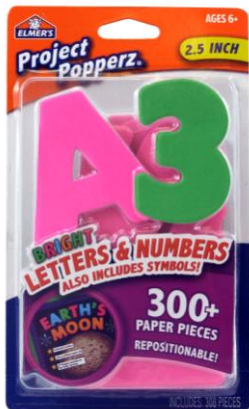

Main Materials:

Elmer's® Foam Board - 12" x 18" bi-fold
Project Popperz® Repositionable Paper Letters & Numbers
Photo - 5" x 7" (if possible)
Cardstock - 2 different colors
3 - 12" x 12" themed or scrap booking papers
Elmer's® School Glue Sticks





Basic Materials:

Scissors
Pencil
Embellishments
Paper towel

Steps:

1. Using the foam board as a guide, measure and cut the themed paper to the size of the front of the card. Apply the glue stick to the foam board and cover with the paper.
2. Using a 12" x 12" themed paper, fold it in half and glue it to the center of the inside of the card.
3. Cut two 12" x 3" pieces of themed paper and glue them to the outer edges of the inside of the card.
4. Cut one piece of cardstock $\frac{1}{2}$ " larger than the picture you are going to use and cut the other piece of cardstock 1" larger than the picture.
5. Glue the picture to the smaller piece of cardstock and then glue that to the larger piece of cardstock to create a nice boarder.
6. Glue the picture to the front of the card and press in place using a paper towel so you don't smudge to picture.
7. Decorate the rest of the card, both inside and out, with the letters and embellishments.
