Pig

Main Supplies:

Plain baseball cap or visor
Elmer's® Glue-All®
Elmer's® Painters® Markers
Elmer's® 3D™ Washable Glitter Paint Pens
Pepperell® Rexlace™ Plastic Lacing
Styrofoam™ Brand Foam Ball- 3"
Wood shapes- two 1 ½" teardrops, one 1" circle







Basic Supplies:

Petal pink acrylic paint 2-8mm wiggle eyes Plastic knife Scissors Stiff paint brush Regular paint brush Masking tape Hole punch

Instructions:

- 1. Place ball on end of skewer. Hold skewer and paint ball petal pink. Paint wood shapes Petal Pink. While pig is drying, place end of skewer into Styrofoam scrap.
- 2. When dry, use black marker to outline wood shapes and for nostrils on snout. Glue snout, teardrops and wiggle eyes to ball. Allow to dry.
- 3. Use the heavy duty hole punch to punch a hole in the center of the bill on the baseball cap.
- 4. Carefully insert skewer completely through ball. Take skewer out of ball and insert wire into ball. Thread one pony bead onto wire sticking out of top of pig head. Use round nose pliers to twist wire around bead to secure head to top of bill. Repeat for bottom of bill with remaining bead.
- 5. Tie ribbon into a bow by wrapping around wire on bottom of pig head. Wear cap to celebrate National Pig Day on March 1st!
