Main Supplies:

Pepperell® Bottle cap charms

Pepperell® Silkie[™] necklace Pepperell® Silkie[™] O beads Elmer's® Painters® Markers Elmer's® White School Glue Elmer's® School Glue Gel







Basic Supplies:

Embellishments-stickers, buttons, flatback crystals 1" decorative paper circle Scissors

Paint brushes

Instructions:

Paint a layer of white school glue onto the back of the bottle cap and place a 1" decorative paper circle on top.

Seal with a layer of clear school glue to make it shine---you can also add the embellishments with this glue too.

Add dots and stripes around the bottle cap with the paint pens and leave to dry.

String as many "O" beads onto the necklace followed by the pendant and more "O" beads.

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
