Ginger Bread Garland Designed by Denise Pylar

Use shaped cookie cutters to create this holiday garland.





Always cover your work surface with a mat or some type of protective covering like wax paper or plastic.

Age Range: 7 to 12

## Main Materials:

Ginger bread shaped cookie cutter Brown paint FloraCraft® Styrofoam™ Brand Foam Pepperell® Rexlace™ Plastic Lacing Elmer's® Craft Bond™ Tacky Glue Blumenthal Lansing® Buttons



### **Basic Materials:**

Stiff paint brush Scissors Skewer Wiggly eyes Ribbon Lace

### Steps:

1. Cut ginger bread man out of Styrofoam using the cookie cutter.

- 2. Paint and let dry.
- 3. Add eyes with a drop of glue.
- 4. Decorate using the ribbon, lace and buttons to create a unique design.

5. Using the skewer, poke a hole where the hands are and push ribbon through with the skewer. Connect your ginger bread men with the ribbon to create a garland.
