Blumenthal Lansing® Buttons



Basic Materials:

Stiff paint brush

Scissors

Skewer

Wiggly eyes

Ribbon

Lace

Steps:

1. Cut ginger bread man out of Styrofoam using the cookie cutter.

2. Paint and let dry.
3. Add eyes with a drop of glue.
4. Decorate using the ribbon, lace and buttons to create a unique design.
5. Using the skewer, poke a hole where the hands are and push ribbon through with the skewer. Connect your ginger bread men with the ribbon to create a garland.
