Main Supplies:

Cupcake papers

Cardstock - colors to match

White yarn - thin, fuzzy

Assorted 1" pompoms

Assorted mini pompoms

Elmer's® Glue-All®

2 ½" FloraCraft® Styrofoam™ Brand Foam ball

Elmer's® 3D™ Washable Glitter Paint Pens





Basic Supplies: \frac{1}{2}" circle punch Paper towels

Scissors
Decorative edge scissors - optional
Pencil
Cup or can with 3" diameter
Skewer

Instructions:

- 1. Use pencil to draw about a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square on colored cardstock. Fill in area with same of color of 3D paint apply a thin even coat. Repeat step with several colors. Let dry.
- 2. Use circle punch to punch circles from each color using up all of glittered paper.
- 3. Apply a small dot of glue to end of white yarn then press onto Styrofoam ball. Wrap ball with yarn till covered, cut end then glue in place. Let dry.
- 4. Place a cupcake paper into cupcake tin. Squeeze a small puddle of Craft Bond Tacky glue onto paper towel. Use finger to apply paint a thin coating around rim on inside of liner. Carefully push yarn ball into liner. Let dry.
- 5. Remove yarn ball from holder which is now glued to cupcake liner.
- 6. Use pencil to trace around can or cup onto cardstock the use decorative edge scissors to cut out. Apply a thin even layer of glue to bottom of cupcake then lightly press into center. Let dry.
- 7. Glue large pompom onto top of cupcake, then glitter circles and small pompoms as shown.
- 8. Add dots of glitter with the glitter pen around edge of cardstock round under cupcake. Let dry.
