Main Supplies: Decorative tea cup Felt - yellow, bright green - or desired colors Old sweater - desired color Ribbon - 1 yard color to match FloraCraft® Styrofoam™ Brand Foam Ball - 3" or size needed to fit cup Elmer's® Craft Bond™ Tacky Glue Elmer's® Project Popperz® Reusable Plastic Stencil Blumenthal Lansing® buttons - 14 - ½" in desired color





Basic Supplies:

Pencil Scissors Damp paper towels Sewing pins

Instructions:

- 1. Remove heart stencil from pack then carefully remove inside of design.
- 2. Place stencil on yellow felt, use pencil to on trace seven or so hearts, then cut out.
- 3. Cut out leaf pattern from paper, place on green felt, trace around with pencil then cutout. Trace and cut two leaves.
- 4. Apply a thin layer of Craft Bond Tacky Glue to lower edge of a leaf then press on rim of cup pressing about $\frac{1}{2}$ " inside. Glue on other leaf where shown.
- 5. To create petals for flower, add glue to one side on point of heart up about $\frac{1}{2}$ " or so then press onto side rim of cup. Equally space and glue on remaining hearts.
- 6. Place Styrofoam ball on sweater then use scissors to carefully cut a circle large enough to cover ball.
- 7. Squeeze glue onto half of foam ball and smooth with fingers. Wipe fingers on dam paper towel if needed. Press sweater in place then pull fabric to cover ball smoothing any tucks that may form.
- 8. Add glue to petals just under rim of cup so it won't show, then carefully press covered ball into place till about $\frac{1}{2}$ is inside cup. Let dry.
- 9. Glue equally spaced buttons around center ball as shown.
- 10. Tie ribbon around cup then tie a bow just above handle. Trim ends.
- 11. Poke pins into ball to secure.

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
