Main Materials: Foam sheets; orange, red and yellow Pipe cleaner Elmer's® Foam Board Elmer's® Black Painters® Marker Elmer's® School Glue






Basic Materials:

Hole punch Craft knife Cutting mat Scissors Ruler Brown, white and yellow paint Paint brush Pencil

Pattern



Steps:

Cut foam board to $3.5" \times 8"$ with the craft knife. Paint the foam board brown and then add yellow dots using the wooden end of the paint brush.

Use the pattern to cut out the feathers, eyes and beak out of the foam sheets. Add polka dots and details using paint or a marker.

Glue on feathers, eyes, beak and feet.

Punch holes in the top and attach pipe cleaner to hang.


Easter Bunny

Main Materials:

Elmer's® School Glue FloraCraft® Styrofoam™ Brand Foam ball - 2", cut in half Elmer's® Foam Board Elmer's® Black Painters Marker

Basic Materials:

Foam sheet - pink Pipe cleaner Hole punch Craft knife Cutting mat Scissors Ruler Paint - pink, black and white Paint brush Black marker Pencil Wooden heart Wooden circles Pattern



Steps:

Cut foam board to $3.5" \times 8"$ with the craft knife. Paint the foam board pink and then add white dots using the wooden end of the paint brush.

Use the pattern to cut out the ears and feet out of the foam sheets. Add polka dots and details using paint or a marker.

Cut pipe cleaners into 6 - 3" lengths. Using 1 of the Styrofoam ball halves for the nose, Poke 3 stems into each side to make wiskers.

Glue on ears, heart nose and feet and add additional details if desired.

Punch holes in the top and attach to hang.
