Basic Materials:

Scissors
Decorative scissors
Large hole punch
Small hole punch
Pencil

Steps:

- 1. Cut out snowman pieces from pattern. Cut carrot nose with decorative scissors.
- 2. Cut a hole for the picture in the center of one of the snowmen pieces using the circle template.
- 3. Punch holes all around snowman (except one side of one snowman where the picture will go in).
- 4. Put the two snowmen together and sew the lacing around the outside.
- 5. Attach bells and pony beads to the lacing and tie around the neck (see picture).
- 6. Glue eyes, nose and mittens on. Draw mouth with marker.
- 7. Put picture in through opening.

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
